- 2. \*Read James 4:13-17. What words or phrases stand out to you? Why?
- 3. \*What does James teach in verse 13 and 14 about our lives? Why is this important to remember?
- 4. In your own words, how should we think about our plans for the future? (Use verse 15 as your quide.)
- 5. \*In verse 17, James tells us: "Do the good you know to do today." Is there anything you know you should be doing today that you're avoiding or that you're distracted from by worries of the future? Commit to getting started.
- 6. Read Proverbs 3:27-28 and ask for help to do what you know you need to do today. Take a moment to pray and commit your future into God's hands.
