3.	In verses 3 and 5, the spirit of the antichrist is described. Antichrist means to say or teach something untrue about Jesus. Why did John say it is so important not to listen to these kinds of teachings?
4.	What else does this passage teach us about false teachers and the spirit of the antichrist? How does John tell his readers that they can overcome the antichrist?
5.	In verses 7-12, what are the reasons John gives for living and loving like Jesus loves us?
6.	What would it look like if you allowed God to live within you? How would your life look different? Is

there someone in your life that you could love better?
